

Basics of Design (I) 1 sem 7 ECTS

Introduction to fundamental design principles: working with form, structure, scale, rhythm, light, and color. Design thinking in the process of developing spatial concepts. Creativity. The challenge of combining intuitive actions with those based on design principles and rules. Analysis and integration of fundamental factors influencing the design process. Design work methodology, encompassing the stages of inspiration, analysis, synthesis, concept development, and project presentation. Basic concepts related to design activities in space (the semantic aspect of interior design). Developing imagination and sensitivity, and thereby artistic awareness.

Principles of constructing spatial forms and structures based on a dedicated modular grid.

Transforming planes into spatial structures of an open and closed interior nature. The issue of assigning meanings and contexts to designed spatial structures in relation to work and rest areas. Recording design concepts in model, graphic, and descriptive forms. Project presentation.
